

Which emails should you delete?

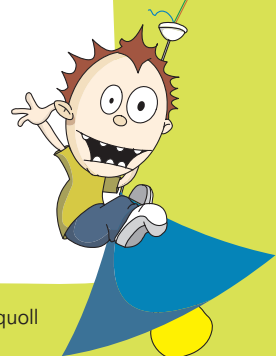
Even if you are very careful about giving out your email address you should always be prepared for emails that you don't want.

Unless you know who Harry is, it is likely that this email is just trying to sell insurance—Bin it.
